

Reconciliation Offering

Born out of the civil unrest that ensued following the martyrdom of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. in 1968, the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) has persistently pursued ways to address the sin of racism through resolutions and direct action in our congregations, Regions, and General Ministries.

The Reconciliation Offering, which is split evenly with the general church, funds our mission priority to become a pro-reconciling/anti-racist church through experiential education, inclusive worship and intentional dialogue across difference.

Funds from the 2011 offering will provide grants for seven such projects in Kansas. To meet all seven requests, our portion of the 2011 Reconciliation Offering must reach \$24,500, so we have set our goal at \$49,000.

By the grace of God we know that all things are possible. Please give generously when the Reconciliation Offering is received in your congregation. This Offering will be received in many of our congregations on September 25th and October 2nd.
